MONDAY 9 FEBRUARY 2026

Spiers & Boden – Multiple BBC Folk Award winners John & Jon have been at the forefront of the English traditional folk scene for 25 years both as a ground breaking duo and as founder members of folk phenomenon Bellowhead. After a seven year hiatus to concentrate on their Universal Records-signed big band Bellowhead they returned as a duo in 2021 and have been taking their brand of high octane, no nonsense acoustic folk song and music to packed UK venues ever since. They have become one of the best loved folk duos.

MONDAY 16 FEBRUARY 2026

SykesMartin – The exciting collaboration from two of British folk's finest voices. Miranda Sykes (Show of Hands) and Hannah Martin (Edgelarks & Gigspanner Big Band) join forces to present a set of songs that take them back to their shared roots. Having played together on numerous occasions, including in Steve Knightley's Wake the Union band, and at the Royal Albert Hall, they knew that they shared an instinctive ear for harmony and skilled instrumental improvisation. A sociable Devon winter evening led to an exchange of songs; which

proved to be so much fun that they soon arranged another musical get together. Swiftly these became rehearsal sessions, as a strong new sound emerged. Centred around their deep knowledge of roots music, and a love of harmony singing, SykesMartin brings together old songs with new ideas on double bass, fiddle, and banjo.

MONDAY 23 FEBRUARY 2026

McGoldrick, McCusker & Doyle - Folk music's legendary triumvirate of musical magpies Mike McGoldrick, John McCusker and John Doyle are back, bringing you their own blend of top - class folk songs, tunes and charming bonhomie. All three have won global acclaim and are musicians in The Transatlantic Sessions: John Dovle (Dublin – vocals, quitar, bouzouki, mandola) is an Irish music linchpin and a founder member of acclaimed group Solas, who has worked with Joan Baez, Linda Thompson and Mary Chapin Carpenter. BBC Radio 2 Folk Award Winner John McCusker (Glasgow – fiddle, whistles, harmonium) has played with The Battlefield Band, Mark Knopfler and Bob Dylan, recorded with Paul Weller and produced albums for Eddi Reader, Heidi Talbot and Kris Drever. Mike McGoldrick (Manchester – flute, whistles, Uileann pipes, bodhran, clarinet, congas) is a BBC Radio 2 Folk Award winner, founding member of Lúnasa, and current member of Capercaillie, who has worked with Mark Knopfler, Eddi Reader and John Cale. Described as the masters of flute, fiddle, song and guitar they'll bring you a night of beautifully crafted music. Mike, John & John are a rare musical treat you'll savour for a very long time.

MONDAY 2 MARCH 2026

Feast of Fiddles – Born in Nettlebed on Valentine's Day 1994 as a one-off special concert, Feast of Fiddles has done spring tours every year since, Have played numerous festivals and has seven CDs to its name. Not bad for a bunch of old folk- rockers! This is a band of friends that puts on a show of huge dynamic range performed with passion, joy and a liberal dose of fun. Six fiddlers, including Phil Beer from the 'Originals' lineup, bring a large range of fiddle playing styles to the rock back-line – all held together by legendary drummer Dave Mattacks. This is a live music entertainment like no other on the circuit which is guaranteed to be enjoyed by even the most doubting of friends dragged along!
